Большевистская, 68)</p> <p>In general, classes for foreign language students are aimed at helping students succeed in the world using the target language. Rarely is real life so neatly navigated; however, and when things don't go as hoped, students may not realize the potential consequences of failure or compliance. This class covers some scenarios where the presenter has encountered difficulty in another culture, commercial, medical, legal, etc. This session will explore topics of student self-competence awareness and strategies for negotiating unsuccessful foreign language encounters as topics for the foreign language classroom.</p>

Drawing on theoretical principles, emphasis is on the critical need to apply those in the management of effective learning. Focus is on three general areas: needs assessment in a variety of real-world contexts: those in which stakeholders' needs are synchronized, known, in conflict and unknown), the role of knowledge (content knowledge and linguistics) and instructional methods (how to deliver instruction for engaged learning).</p>

Additionally, once textbooks reach the classroom, they may already be somewhat out of touch with how the language has advanced. Moreover, regarding dialects of English, textbooks tend to prefer one variety over another.
