Pronouns (personal, demonstrative, possessive, impersonal, indefinitely personal, negative). Cardinal and ordinal numbers. • Weeks 6-11. Conjugation of the verb in the present tense. Modal verbs. Imperative mood in German. • Weeks 12-18. Articles. Prepositions.
